Preston: A diverse northern suburb with a significant social sector

Preston sits approximately 9 kilometres north of Melbourne's CBD in the City of Darebin. It's one of Melbourne's larger and more diverse northern suburbs — substantial residential population, an active commercial strip along High Street, a significant industrial and warehousing belt, and a large concentration of not-for-profit, social services, and community organisations.

Preston's NFP and social services sector accounts for a meaningful share of the suburb's daytime economy. Organisations providing children's services, family support, disability services, mental health support, emergency accommodation, and community legal services have significant operational presences in Preston and surrounding Darebin suburbs. Berry Street — one of Australia's most prominent child and family welfare organisations — operates from Preston and is representative of the calibre of organisation that chooses to base its operations in this community.

The commercial sector in Preston is anchored by High Street, one of Melbourne's longest and most diverse retail strips, alongside the commercial precinct around Bell Street and the industrial corridors running east through Reservoir. These tenancies create a broad and varied cleaning market across retail, office, and industrial environments.

Berry Street Preston: Realcorp's NFP anchor client

Berry Street is a leading Australian organisation delivering services to vulnerable children, young people, and families. Their Preston operation is a significant service hub — an office environment where staff work with clients who may be in crisis, where confidentiality and a calm, professional setting are operationally important, and where every person cleaning the building must be police-cleared without exception.

Realcorp's cleaning program at Berry Street Preston covers office and common area cleaning structured around Berry Street's operational schedule and the specific requirements of a social services environment:

- **Office and workstation cleaning** — systematic cleaning of staff workspaces, meeting rooms, and counselling rooms with direct attention to confidentiality: no reading of client materials, no disruption of case files
- **Client-facing reception and waiting areas** — maintaining a clean, welcoming environment for clients who may be attending in distress
- **Kitchen and amenity areas** — daily cleaning of staff kitchen, food preparation areas, and amenity rooms
- **Bathrooms** — hygiene cleaning of staff and client bathroom facilities
- **Common corridors and entry areas** — lobby and corridor cleaning maintaining a professional, calm presentation throughout the building

Cleaning a social services organisation like Berry Street is not the same as cleaning a standard commercial office. Staff work with clients experiencing significant life challenges. The physical environment must support that work — clean, calm, professional, and free from distraction. Realcorp's team at Berry Street understands that context and is briefed accordingly.

NFP and social services cleaning requirements in Preston

Beyond Berry Street, Preston's NFP sector includes community health centres, disability service providers, family support organisations, and emergency accommodation facilities. These organisations share specific cleaning requirements that separate them from standard commercial contracts.

Police clearances are mandatory. Any cleaning contractor entering a facility that works with children, people with disability, or other vulnerable populations must ensure all staff hold current Working With Children Checks and, where required, NDIS Worker Screening clearances in addition to national police checks. Realcorp manages all required clearances for staff working in these environments as part of our standard employment process — not as an add-on.

Social services organisations typically have restricted access areas too: client interview rooms, accommodation areas, secure records storage. Realcorp staff are briefed on access protocols for each facility and operate within those boundaries.

Consistency and verified accountability matter just as much. Organisations working with vulnerable people need to know exactly who is in their building. Subcontractor and labour-hire arrangements erode that accountability because the chain of responsibility becomes diffuse. Realcorp's direct employment model means every NFP client in Preston can verify that the same vetted, trained employees are cleaning their facility — every visit.

In Preston's NFP and social services sector, direct employment isn't a preference — it's a baseline compliance requirement. Organisations like Berry Street that work with children and vulnerable populations must be able to verify who is entering their facilities. Subcontractor arrangements make that verification structurally impossible, because the cleaning company placing the worker does not directly employ them and cannot guarantee their clearances or conduct.

Realcorp's model is built differently:
